## Introduction & Methodology

- In the following report, Hanover Research presents the results of a senior plans and satisfaction survey administered on behalf of Kenai Peninsula Borough School District (KPBSD).
- This report provides key findings and aggregate charts for senior responses from the 2018 survey administration.
- A total of 131 seniors provided quality survey responses in 2018. Sample sizes vary across
  questions as some questions only pertain to a subset of respondents.
- Conclusions drawn from a small sample size (n<20) should be interpreted with caution.</li>
- For full aggregate and segmented results, please consult the accompanying data supplement. The data supplement provides data for both the 2017 and 2018 survey administrations.
- After data collection, Hanover identified and removed low-quality respondents.
- "Don't Know" or "Not Applicable" responses, and equivalent, are often excluded from the figures and analysis in order to focus on respondents who did express an opinion

## **Key Findings**


- Overall, most seniors believe that their high school experience prepared them for their post-graduation plans. Most respondents are satisfied with their high school preparation in English/writing (85%), science (77%), social studies (72%), and mathematics (73%). Additionally, two-thirds or more of respondents are satisfied with their preparation in problem solving (69%), research skills (66%), and critical thinking (69%). Furthermore, over two-thirds of respondents agree that KPBSD provides students with the academic support they need to succeed (68%).
- KPBSD may increase its focus on career preparation. Less than half of student respondents note satisfaction with the career and technical education provided by KPBSD (44% satisfied; 36% neither satisfied nor dissatisfied) and only and a little over half agree that KPBSD offers an appropriate number and variety of vocational/CTE opportunities (56% agree; 30% neither agree nor disagree). Furthermore, one-quarter of respondents indicate that KPBSD should place more emphasis on Career and Technical Education (26%).
- Students may benefit from a stronger focus on personal finance and postsecondary financial options. About one-third of student respondents are satisfied with the personal finance preparation at KPBSD (35% satisfied; 30% neither satisfied nor dissatisfied). Around one-fifth of respondents who are not planning on entering postsecondary education report they cannot afford school (19%) and one-third indicate that they need to work to support themselves (33%).
- Nearly half of seniors plan on leaving the state after graduation (49%) and over half plan on continuing their education (71%). About one-third of respondents (32%) plan on staying in the Kenai Peninsula. Additionally, 15 percent of respondents plan on finding a part-time or full-time job instead of continuing their education.





# Do you participate in any of the following extracurricular activities at KPBSD? (n=90)





#### Which of the following best describes your postgraduation plans? (n=118)




#### Please specify the location of your postgraduation plans. (n=121)



Which of the following factor(s) led to your decision not to continue your education following graduation from high school? (n=36)




In which field do you expect to work following graduation? Please select a maximum of three options. (n=30)










## Preparation for Post-Grad Plans

Please rate your level of satisfaction with the support you have received from your high school in the following areas.




#### Preparation for Post-Grad Plans

# In which of the following areas do you believe KPBSD should place more emphasis? (n=93)




