
RE: KPBSD Graduation Rate

This review will also include discussion about recent District efforts and committee work to support graduation rate improvement efforts.

Graduation Rate as defined by Alaska Department of Education & Early Development for AYP purposes:

Number of Graduates (Regular Diplomas)


(Number of Graduates +
Grade 9 Dropouts - three school years prior +
Grade 10 unduplicated Dropouts - two school years prior +
Grade 11 unduplicated Dropouts - prior school year +
Grade 12 unduplicated Dropouts - current school year +
Grade 12 Continuing Students (includes students receiving Certificates of Acheivement)

Dropout Rate - as defined by Alaska Department of Education & Early Development to be included in the District/School Report Card to the Public.

The Dropout Rate is a fraction, the numerator of which is the number of students who have dropped out in the <u>current</u> school year, and the denominator of which is the number of students enrolled in grades 7 - 12 on October 1 of the current school year.
