The Third-Party Administrator (TPA) is EBMS (in Montana) & Prescription Benefit Manager (PBM) is Caremark. Since claims are pooled state-wide, rates are not based on KPBSD claims experience, and no claim reports KPBSD specific are provided. 60-day notice to terminate with a 90-day run-out period and no actuarial data will be provided upon termination.
