Pre-K Curriculum Meeting Minutes

October 22, 2015

The Pre-K Curriculum Committee began the meeting establishing group norms and outcomes for their work together. After reviewing Board Policy 6141 pertaining to curriculum development, the committee created a historical timeline of KPBSD Pre-K programming.

Next, the Committee reviewed and prioritized the essential components of a Pre-K curriculum. We then reviewed current pacing and curriculum documents and re-evaluated and analyzed the coherence of these documents with the essential components we identified.

The committee revised three of the five domains identified in Alaska's early childhood standards.

The agenda for the next meeting will be to continue prioritizing the standards for Domains 4 and 5. We will also identify essential questions and big ideas for each priority standard. Finally, we will include instructional strategies adults can use to increase student success on the identified standards.
