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Skills

Beginner:

- Sing accurately from a given pitch with no or little outside support.
- Sing music in 1-2 parts, rounds and partner songs at a level of 1-2.
- Explore vocal tone on a continuum.
- Sight sing melodies at a difficultly level of 1-2.
- Identify and perform simple dynamic contrasts.
- Perform a varied repertoire of music.
- Perform in scheduled concerts in appropriate concert attire with appropriate concert behavior.

Novice:

- Sing music written in 1-4 parts at a difficulty level of 2-3.
- Identifying vocal tone on a continuum (feathery, airy, firm, rich, brassy, edgy etc.).
- Sight sing melodies at a difficulty level of 1-3.
- Stand and sing using proper posture.
- Pitch matching, interval study, scales, diction, and enunciation.
- Identify and perform dynamic contrasts and tempo markings indicated in the score.
- Identify and perform musical phrases.
- Perform music in a foreign language.
- Use self-reflection and peer feedback to refine individual and ensemble performance.

Intermediate/Advanced:

- Sing music written in 1-4 parts including divisi at a difficulty level of 3-4.
- Perform vocal tone on a continuum (feathery, airy, firm, rich, brassy, edgy etc.)
- Sight sing melodies in the appropriate clef at a difficulty level of 2-4.
- Identify and perform dynamic contrasts, tempo markings and phrasing indicated and implied in the score.
- Develop strategies to address technical challenges and evaluate the success of those strategies.

Advanced:

- Sing music written in 4-8 parts including divisi at a difficulty level 4-5.
- Demonstrate ability by singing in small groups 1-2 people per part in 4-8 part music.
- Perform expressively subtle dynamic contrasts and tempo markings in phrasing throughout a piece of music.
