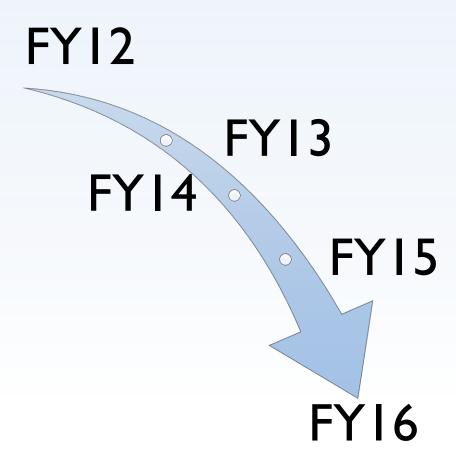

FY17 Preliminary Budget Reduction Details

Total Reductions to FY17 Preliminary Budget	(\$3,436,829)
Add back 13.50 FTE Teachers	1,161,000
Change in method for estimated Salary and Benefits budget	(902,436)
Reduce transfer to Food Service	(100,000)
Teachers (25.65 FTE), Counselor (1.0 FTE), Sch Adm (1.0 FTE)	(2,537,995)
Services, Software, Equipment	(415,050)
District Office Supplies, Travel, Professional and Technical	
District Office Staff (5.26 FTE)	(\$642,348)



State Funding Changes after Legislature adjourned

- Governor's veto of the amount equal to \$50 in BSA was later reinstated (\$444,812)
- Governor's veto of \$655,072 from Student Transportation fund was <u>not</u> reinstated



Additional FY17 Budget Changes after School Board approval in April 2016

Reduced Expenditures:
 District Office staff (cut 2.80 FTE, total 8.06 FTE) (\$352,851)

Reduced Revenues:
 Kenai Peninsula Borough revenue not as anticipated (\$782,622)
