1 Login to Powerschool, on the left hand menu, select Career Plan

2 Your Screen should display the most recent information you have saved in your PLCP from AKCIS

3 If you would like to update your PLCP, you can login to your AKCIS account from Powerschool. In AKCIS Hover over My Portfolio > Click on Personal Learning and Career Plan

4 The items we update are "My Education Plans," "Career Clusters of Interest," and "Occupations and Clusters of Interest."

***It takes 24 hours for this information to populate in to your Powerschool Account**
