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This application is open to all graduating seniors in the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District who meet the following criteria:

1. A minimum of six (6) semesters and/or three (3) credits of career & technical education.
2. A minimum of two (2) semesters in the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District
3. An overall GPA OF 2.5 or better.
A career & technical GPA of 3.0 or better.
4. Submit a typewritten essay of 150 to 300 words on their career goals, community involvement, and financial needs. **Essay 20 points**
5. Submit a one-page resume. **Resume 10 points**
6. Submit the attached application: **Application 60 points**

In the application please demonstrate:

- Leadership skills
 - Community service
 - Employability or work experience
 - Involvement in clubs and organizations, CTSO (Career & Technical Student Organization) participation preferred
 - Academic achievement
 - Career & technical achievement
7. Attach three (3) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from someone outside of their school. **Recommendation letters 10 points**
 8. An interview may or may not be requested as a part of the scholarship selection.
