Suggestions:

- 1. Reduce/Combine Standing Committees to a total of 3 with 3 (unduplicated) members each. These are our working committees. The Board goals will be tied to each.
- 2. Committees would focus on the purpose of the Board is 1) Advocate for District and communicate with the public; 2) Approve policies and oversee administration; 3) Assure quality curriculum and instruction.
- 3. Committees would generally mirror District departments.
- 4. Standing committees would most likely meet prior to all/most Board work sessions on meeting days. We could build in meetings for 75 minutes followed by a 15 minute break and work sessions.
- 5. Staff would work with just one standing committee as they relate to departments. Additional department staff may also participate/substitute as needed or when another committee's agenda overlaps.

Governance and Communications Committee

Staff: Steve Atwater and/or Pegge Erkeneff

This committee would focus on tracking local, state, and national issues (one member for each) for legislative advocacy, informing the board, and recommending specific advocacy steps. This group would also reach out to the public with documents and media to inform the public on District challenges and success to engage our communities to support our schools. Other areas falling under this committee would be supporting site based councils, Board bylaws and procedures, and community relations.

Board Goal: 3. Improve site council effectiveness by developing a set of guidelines and responsibilities for site councils by March 2013 (support Strategic Plan Goal 3.1)

Policy, Administration and Budget Committee

Staff: Dave Jones and/or Laurie Olson and/or Tim Peterson

This committee would continue the work of the Policy Committee and provide input on administrative issues related to budget, personnel, transportation, facilities, and operations.

Board Goal: 1. Define and document KPBSD School Board's relationship with the KP Borough regarding school facilities, their maintenance, and local funding by December 2012.

4. Examine KPBSD's student transportation system to identify inefficiencies and then develop a plan for improving District transportation by December 2013.

Curriculum and Instruction Committee
