Using the Daily 5 structure in both the elementary and secondary classrooms provides students with structures that help create a personalized learning environment. Razdolna does a pretty good job looking at a variety of daily/weekly assessments that compare our population of students, but the current national assessments do not take into account our culture or language, and therefore doesn't reflect well for our ELL students. Razdolna uses a variety of ways to measure growth including growth charts, tests and labs, by demonstration, assignment rubrics, allowing for written and verbal answers, and project-based assessments. Staff could have more k12 conversations about academic content and expectations to build continuity, which would increase rigor!	Advancing
