As the Kenai Peninsula Borough Finance Director, Jeff works closely with the school district to explore new and additional avenues for school revenues. The district administration thanks Jeff for his willingness to work in collaboration with the school district to resolve financial issues that periodically arise.

In the midst of declining enrollment that resulted in reduced student funding from the State, Jeff researched the Kenai Peninsula Borough interest allocation policies and procedures to see if there was a way to assist the District financially. The result of Jeff's efforts left the District with an additional sum of \$1.76 million in revenue in FY02 and an annual allocation of interest revenue henceforth. This financial assistance allowed the District to significantly limit budget reductions for FY03.

Jeff was instrumental in assisting the District in arranging financing for the Konica copier equipment purchase. This process involved working with bond attorneys, borough ordinances and financial institutions. Jeff's willingness to be a resource to the District throughout this process is greatly appreciated.

Jeff also helped facilitate the purchase of a badly needed warehouse delivery truck through the Borough's equipment replacement fund.

These are only a sampling of ways that Jeff has assisted the district this year alone. Jeff's continued direct support of the District and indirect support of students is greatly appreciated. This evening, we the Board of Education are pleased to recognize Jeff Sinz for his outstanding service to the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District by awarding him with a Golden Apple Award.
