SCHOOL REPORT: Mrs. Sharon Moock, Soldotna Middle School principal, gave a PowerPoint presentation highlighting AYP results, elective course offerings, the school mission statement and goals (improve reading comprehension and improve math measurement as well as estimation and computation scores on the 2006 SBA tests), enrollment information, current and future pupil-teacher ratios, report card information, parent comments, and options for electives next year. Mr. Harro and students from the digital storytelling class presented a video clip of what incoming seventh grade students need to know about Soldotna Middle School. Mrs. Eggelston's graphic design students printed a synopsis of the courses offered at SMS and presented a letter of appreciation to the Board for their service in observance of School Board Appreciation Month.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:** Dr. Peterson reported that on Wednesday, February 15 she attended the Caring for Kenai presentation during the Soldotna Chamber of Commerce meeting.
