The following are from the existing negotiated agreements; however, new agreements are currently under discussion.

Certified Negotiated agreement: "The effective length of the contract shall normally be a maximum of 188 teacher days never to include more than 180 student days in session and three (3) teacher workshop days. In the event that the calendar configuration necessitates the inclusion of both the Labor Day and Memorial Day Holidays, the teacher contract shall be 189 days to accommodate the additional holiday."

Classified Negotiated agreement: "ARTICLE 19: HOLIDAYS: All permanent and permanent part-time employees will receive the following paid holidays if included in their work year: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and the day after Thanksgiving, the day before Christmas and Christmas Day. In addition, each twelve (12) month employee shall have one (1) floating holiday to be used at the employee's discretion. Holidays Falling on Weekend ~ If any of the above holidays fall on Sunday, the following Monday shall be considered the legal holiday. When any of the above holidays fall on Saturday, the Friday immediately preceding the holiday shall be considered to be the holiday."
