SUBJECT: KCHS Modifications

Shell Offshore Inc. has contracted with the University of Alaska to provide a helicopter underwater egress training development and investment service. The contract includes the construction of modifications to the Kenai Central High School facility, the installation of the helicopter underwater egress training facility, and the delivery of training services using the facilities.

According to BP 1330, "The Board encourages community groups to use the school facilities for civic, educational, cultural, and recreational purposes. School related activities shall take precedence over other use of school facilities. When not in conflict with this primary mission, facilities should be available for community use as much as possible, subject to the following limitations:

- 1. Rental fees should be charged as defined by regulation.
- 2. Facility use must preserve facilities and properties for district educational programs.
- 3. Facility use should be scheduled through the principal."

Therefore, the District Administration has been working cooperatively to meet the restrictive short timeline for accommodating this community request.
