


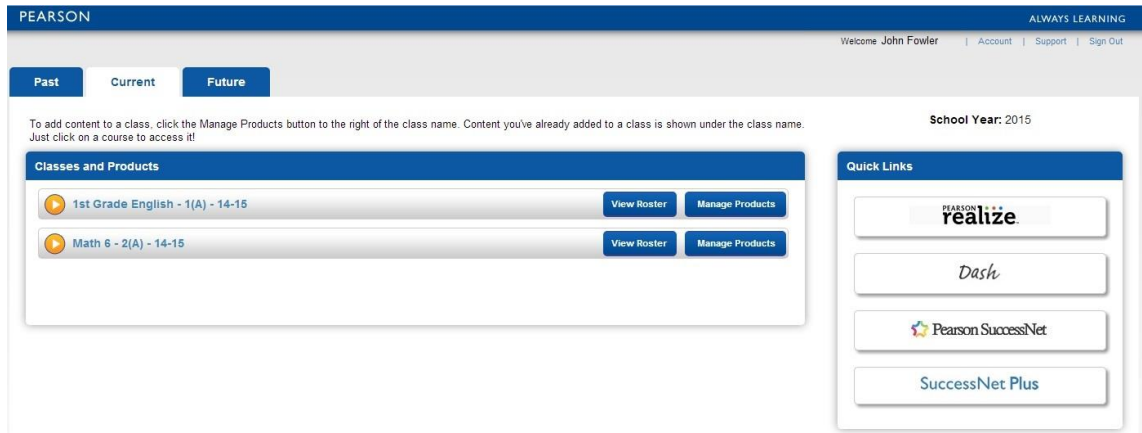

**\*\* If you are using a third party system, your link may have directed you to your Pearson Digital Learning Platform.**

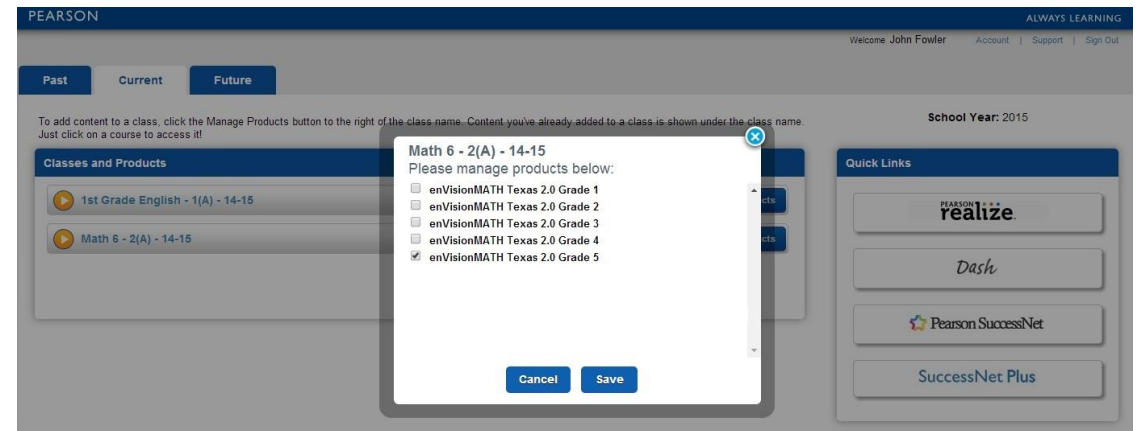


**Step 3:**

Digital curriculum products are associated with classes at the beginning of the school year or term.

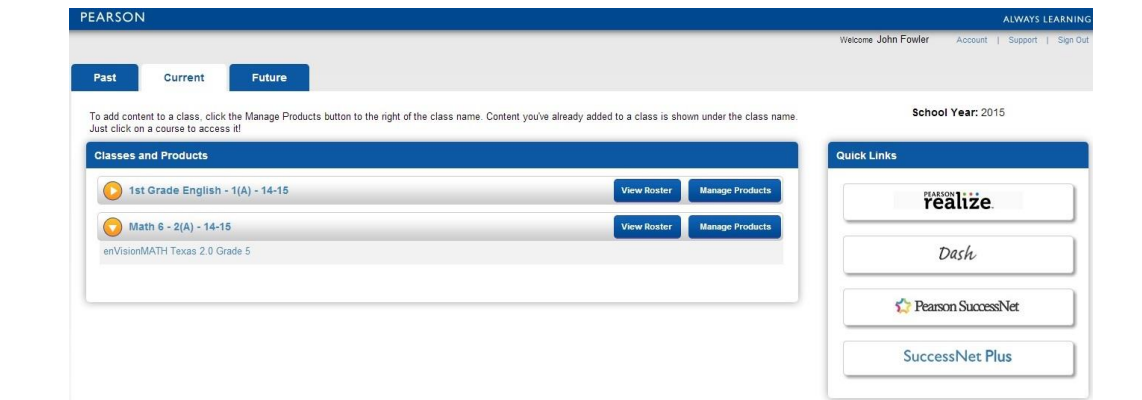
Click **Manage Products**.

<p><b>Step 6:</b></p> <p>Access curriculum and assign content as you did in the past.</p>
