PGKP CODE OF CONDUCT

The Three "R's" Respect for Self
Respect for Others
Responsibility for Self and Actions

CONSEQUENCES

First Offense: Student warning
Second or Serious Offense: Student will be sent home at parents' expense; and will not return.

ZERO TOLERANCE

There will be ZERO tolerance for physical or emotional abuse, drug, alcohol, tobacco use, stimulant drinks (ex: Red Bull, Monster), concealing/keeping forbidden items (ex: cell phones/technical toys), leaving supervised area, or disrespect to Chaperones/Coordinator.
If a Zero Tolerance Offense is committed, the student may be expelled from the field trip and sent home at parent's expense.

No Toys!

All cell phones; I-pods; computer equipment will be turned into PGKP at start of field trip; devices will be returned at end of field trip.

Parent/Family Visits

Although PGKP encourages parents/caretakers to attend events with their student, students will NOT be allowed to leave and return during trips/events. **Students who leave will not be allowed to return.** To release a student during an event, parents/caretakers will need to turn in a signed permission slip for pre-approval with PGKP Executive Director at which point the family accepts responsibility of any return transportation.
