In the spirit of assisting families in the Commercial Fishing/Maritime Trade in the state of Alaska, we are offering scholarships to 2020 High School graduates who are, or a member of their immediate family are, actively involved in the commercial fishing/maritime trade in the state of Alaska. These scholarships will be awarded to assist in covering the costs of tuition, room and board, books, lab fees, etc. at an accredited college, university, or vocational/trade school.

Eligibility for these scholarships include:

Applicant must be currently enrolled in a Lower Kenai Peninsula Area High School from Ninilchik south to Homer to East End Road to across the Bay to Seldovia.

Applicants must be a graduate of the Class of 2020 with either a high school diploma or GED.

Applicant or a member of their immediate family must be involved in commercial fisheries/maritime trade in the state of Alaska.

Special consideration will be made to an applicant who has lost an immediate family member at sea.
