AWARD: There will be two (2) scholarships awarded in the amount of \$500, to a High School Senior, Flex School and/or Home School Senior Student.. Applications available at your high school counselor's office or the American Legion Auxiliary - Homer.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicant GPA 2 – 3.5 student who has applied for or has been accepted in an accredited college, university or vocational technical institution.
2. Applicant does NOT need to be a member of the American Legion Organization but must be an Alaskan resident.
3. Applicant must be a graduate of a school located on the lower Kenai Peninsula, from Anchor Point south, Nikolaevsk, East End Road and including the communities across Kachemak Bay.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

This is a competitive application process. Selection will be made without regard for race, color, national origin, or sex of candidate. Applicants will be judged on:

- a. Completion of application packet
- b. Personal essay
- c. Two letters of recommendation from teachers or counselors
- d. Financial plan which should demonstrate that your goals are attainable.

RULES:

1. The scholarship must be used within twelve (12) months of the date that the winner receives notification of award..
2. The award will be paid directly to the school upon receipt of proof of enrollment.
